into a circle.

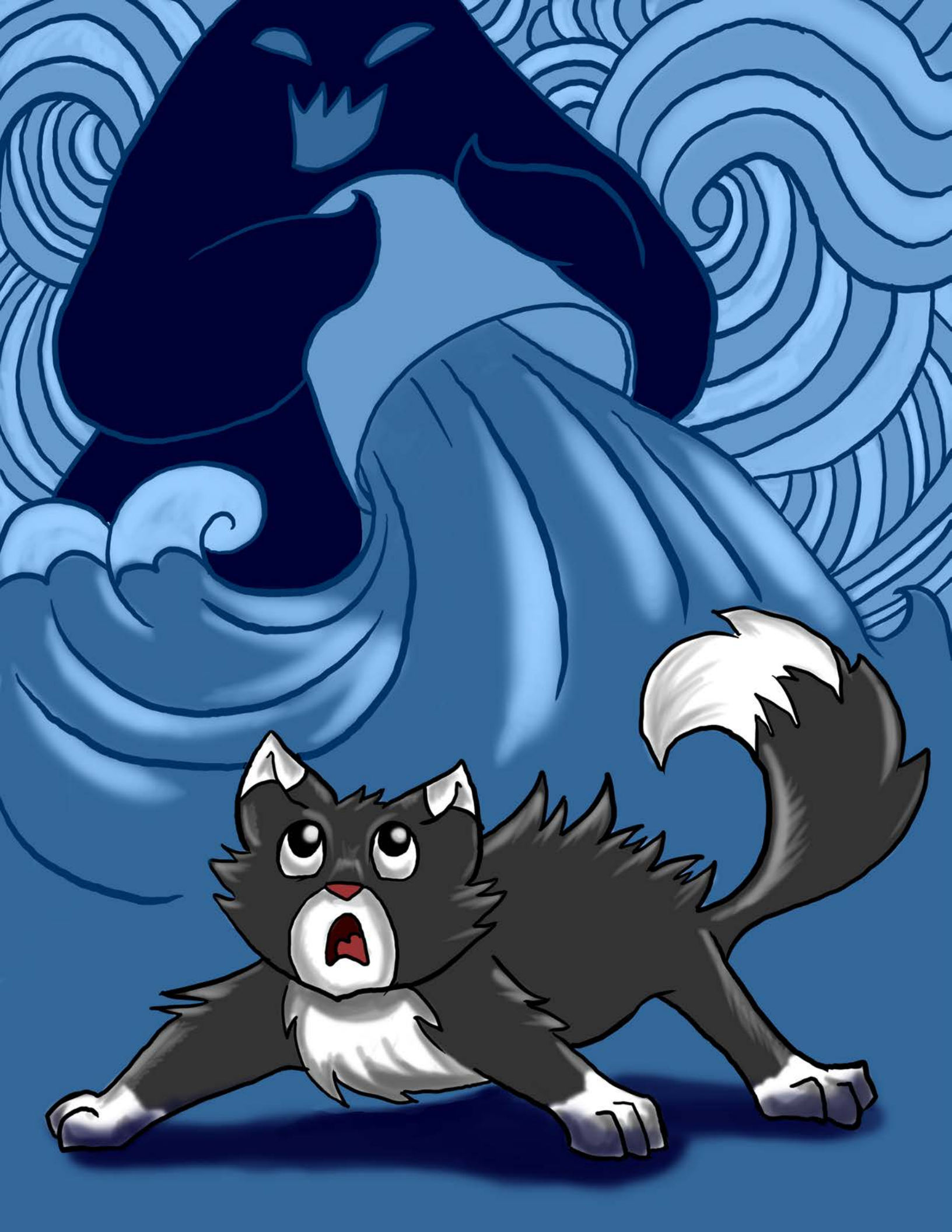




nd had a dream.
